AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING WATER AND SEWER SERVICE FOR OCCUPIED STRUCTURES IN THE CITY OF LEETON, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, it is essential to maintenance of the public health and welfare that proper sanitation be maintained within the City of Leeton, and recreation

WHEREAS, disposal of waste water into a public sewer is a critical aspect of maintaining the public health, and

WHEREAS, connection to a clean and sanitary water supply by all residents not only promotes proper disposal of waste water, it also aids in suppression of disease and maintenance of the public health and welfare,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LEETON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section One</u>. Each structure occupied for residential or commercial purposes shall have active service to the public water and public sewer systems. It shall be unlawful for any person to occupy a structure within the City for residential or commercial purposes that does not have an active public water and public sewer connection.

<u>Section Two</u>. For purposes of this ordinance, "occupied" shall mean any structure in which human inhabitants are present either overnight or for more than three hours in any 24 hour period.

<u>Section Three</u>. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
